- In 2002, Premier Smith promised to renovate the St. George's Police Station. Now, four weeks before an election, Col. Burch promises to renovate the St. George's Police Station again.
- In June 2005, 98 lottery winners were promised affordable homes in Southside. In November 2006, the Southside project was called "in progress". In May 2007, Col. Burch tells lottery winners that work will begin at the end of the month. As of today, there are still no new homes on-site.
- In 2004, the PLP government gives an exclusive deal to develop Club Med to Quorum. In January 2006, Quorum is dropped for KJA. In November 2006, KJA is dropped for Bazarian International. In May this year, Premier Brown said "Construction will begin on the new hotel in St. George's. I can promise you it will be delivered." Last week, the Premier said demolition is "likely" before the end of the year.
